

Regional highlights from the 2017 BC Child Poverty Report Card – Bulkley-Nechako

In Bulkley-Nechako, 1,910 children are living in poverty: more than **one in five** children. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region. Lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are more than **six times higher** for children in lone-parent families than children in couple families. 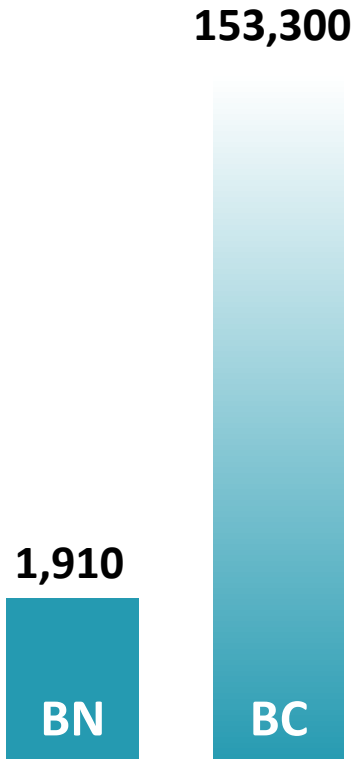

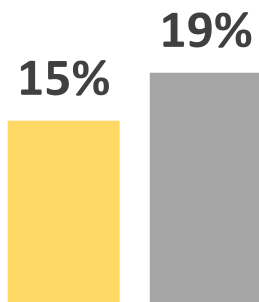

Comparison of Bulkley-Nechako Regional District to British Columbia

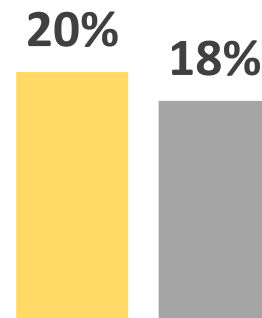
No. of Children Living in Poverty



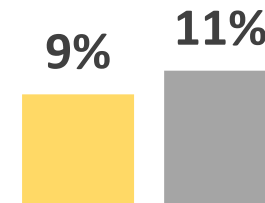
Poverty Rate for all Residents
