

## Regional highlights from the 2017 BC Child Poverty Report Card – Fraser-Fort George

In Fraser-Fort George, **3,370 children** are living in poverty: more than **one in six children**. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region. Lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are more than **eight times higher** for children in lone-parent families than children in couple families. (Source: Statistics Canada, 2015 data)

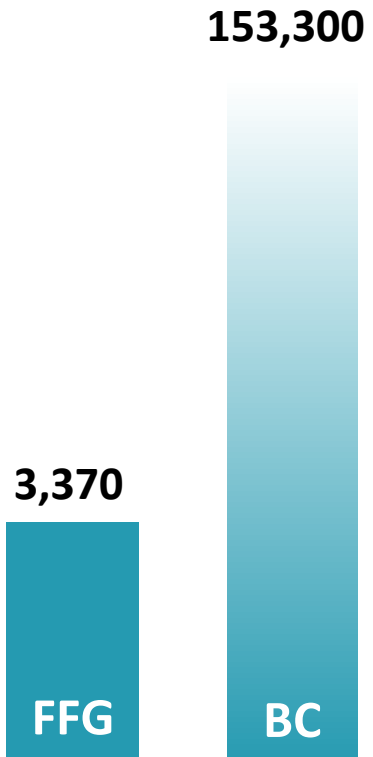

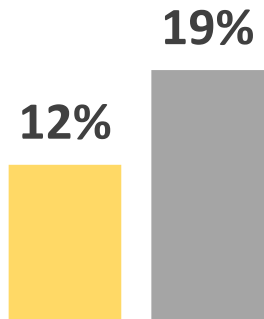

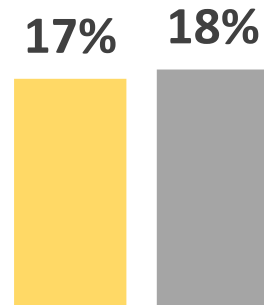
## No. of Children Living in Poverty



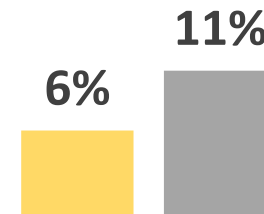
## Poverty Rate for all Residents
