

Regional highlights from the 2017 BC Child Poverty Report Card – Fraser Valley

In Fraser Valley, **11,750 children** are living in poverty: more than **one in six children**. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region. Lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are **nearly six times higher** for children in lone-parent families than children in couple families. 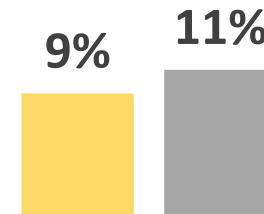
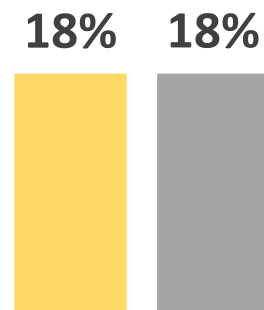
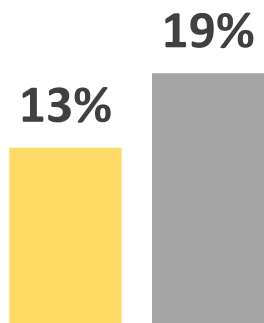
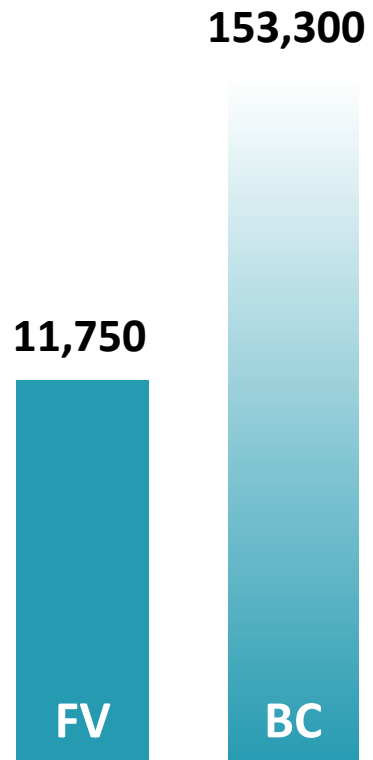
