

Regional highlights from the 2017 BC Child Poverty Report Card – Greater Vancouver

In Greater Vancouver, **76,880 children** are living in poverty: more than **one in six children**. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region. Single-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are nearly **four times higher** for children in single-parent families than children in couple-parent families. (Source: Statistics Canada, 2015 data)

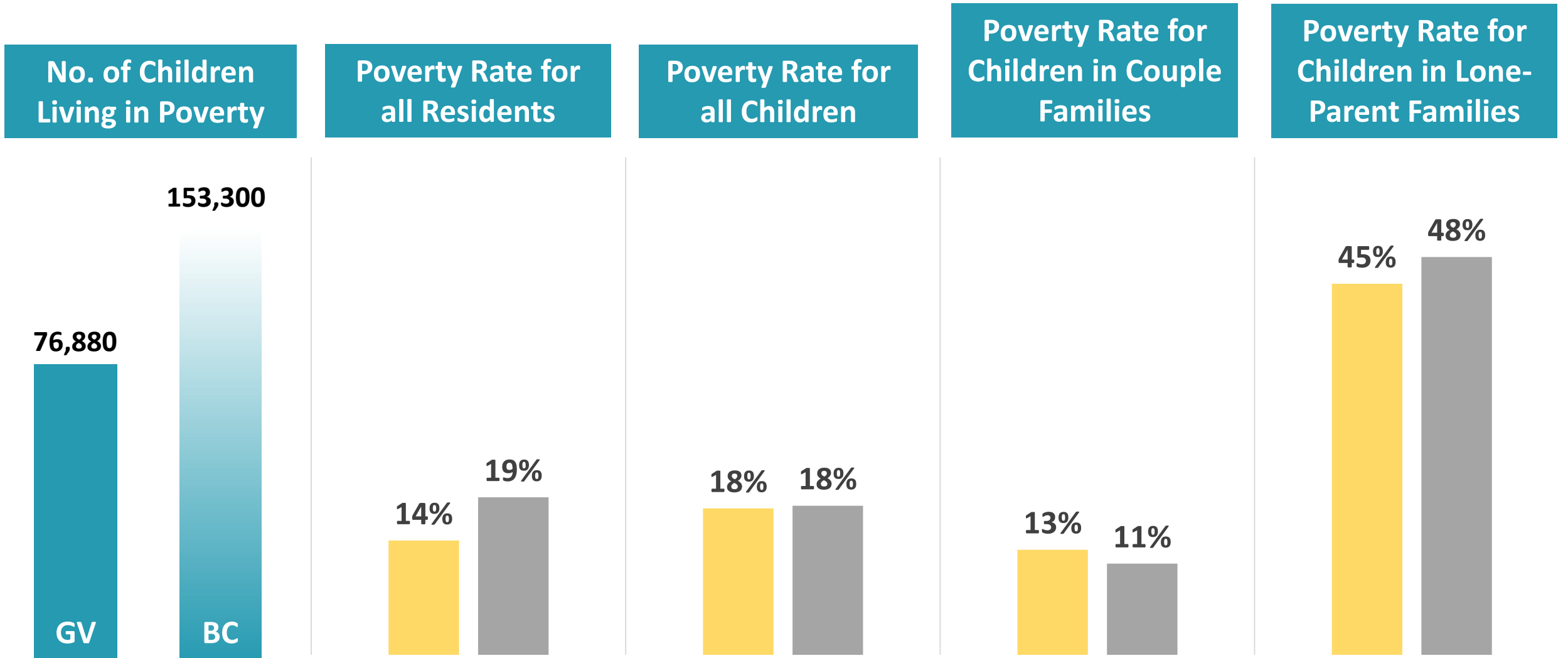
