

Regional highlights from the 2017 BC Child Poverty Report Card – North Okanagan

In North Okanagan, 2,910 children are living in poverty: close to one in five children. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region. Lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are nearly five times higher for children in lone-parent families than children in couple families. (Source: Statistics Canada, 2015 data)

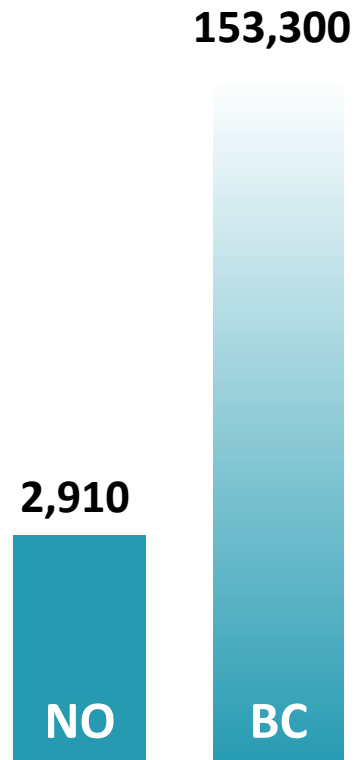

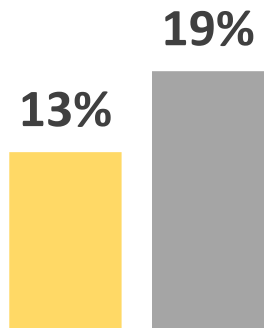

Comparison of North Okanagan Regional District to British Columbia

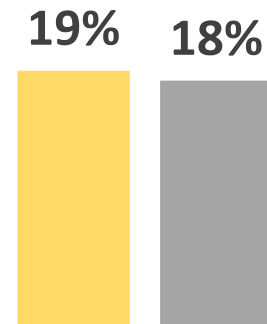
No. of Children Living in Poverty



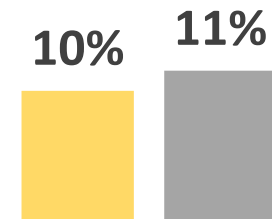
Poverty Rate for all Residents
