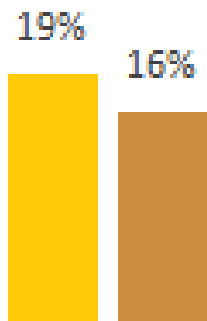
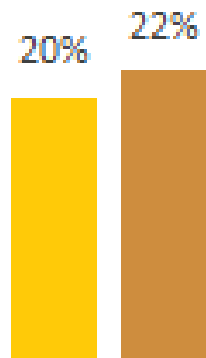

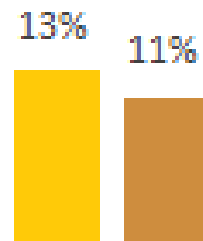
Poverty Rate for all Residents



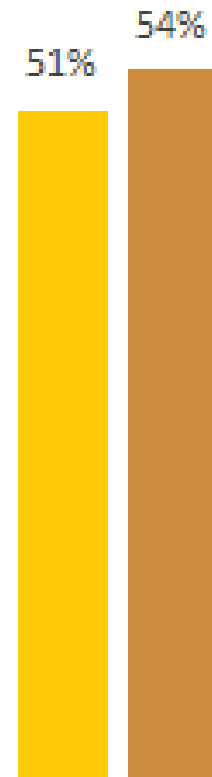
Poverty Rate for all Children

Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Central Okanagan-Similkameen-Nicola riding, 4,020 children are living in poverty: one and a half out of five children. Children in lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are five times higher for children in lone-parent families than children in couple families. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region with the rate being 6% higher for children than the overall population in this area.
