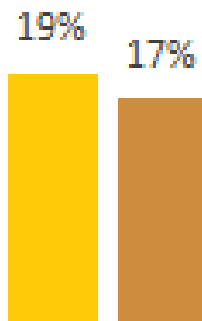
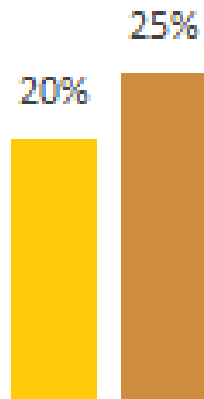

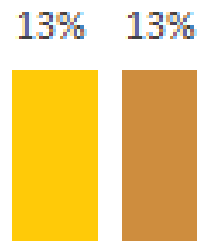
Poverty Rate for all Residents



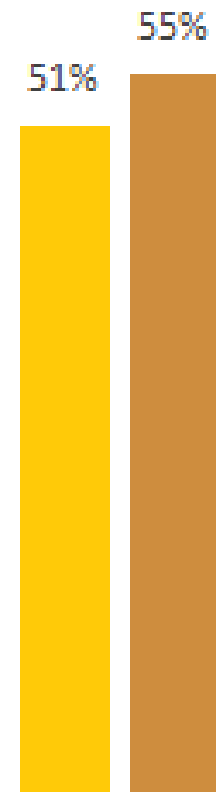
Poverty Rate for all Children

## Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Courtenay-Alberni, 4,490 children are living in poverty: one in four children. Overall child poverty rates are 5% higher than the provincial average. Children in lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are over four times higher for children in lone-parent families than those in couple families. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region with the rate being 8% higher for children.
