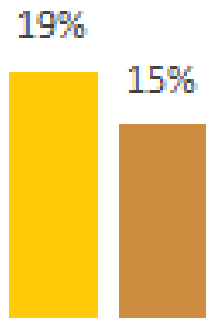

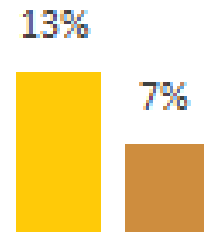
Poverty Rate for all Residents



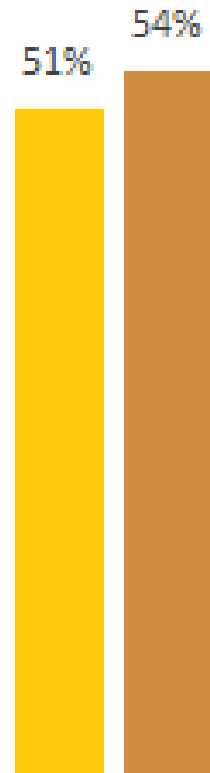
Poverty Rate for all Children

Regional highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Fraser-Fort George regional district, 3,810 children live in poverty: one in five children. Children in lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are seven and a half times higher for children in lone-parent families compared to those in couple families. This is demonstrated in that the rate for couple families is nearly half the provincial rate, but the rate for lone-parent families is 3% higher than the provincial rate.
