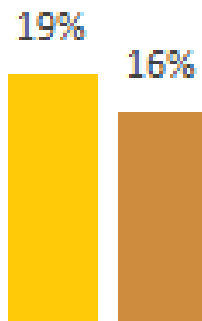

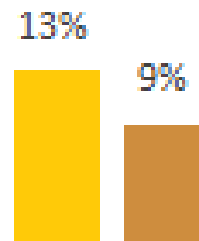
Poverty Rate for all Residents



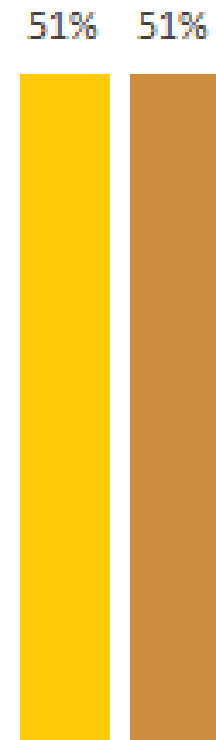
Poverty Rate for all Children

Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Kamloops-Thompson-Cariboo riding, 4,260 children live in poverty: nearly one in five children. Children in lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are five and a half times higher for children in lone-parent families than those in couple families.
