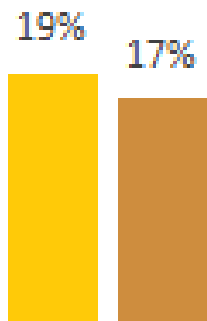

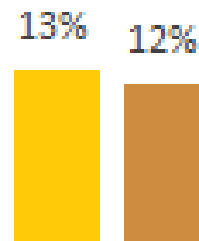
Poverty Rate for all Residents



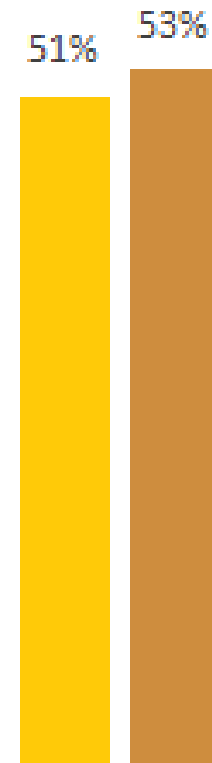
Poverty Rate for all Children

Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Nanaimo-Ladysmith riding, 4,900 children live in poverty: nearly one in four children. Children in lone-parent families are particularly vulnerable: child poverty rates are four and a half times higher for children in lone-parent families than those in couple families. Children are at greater risk of poverty than the overall population of the region with the rate being 6% higher for children.
