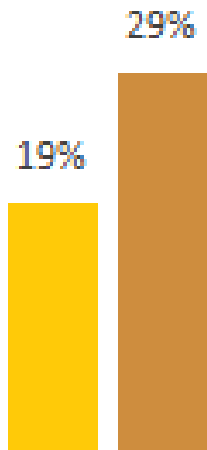
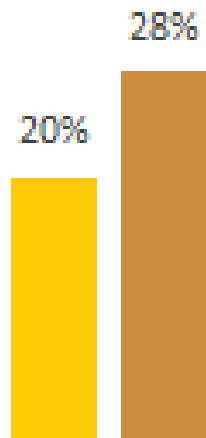

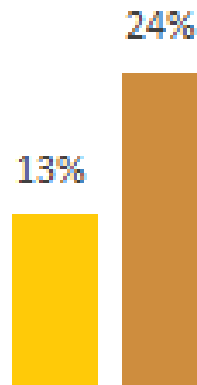
Poverty Rate for all Residents



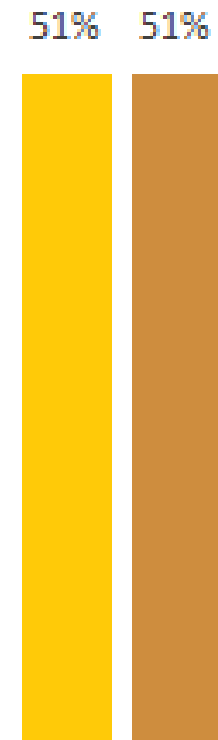
Poverty Rate for all Children

Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Richmond Centre riding, 4,450 children are living in poverty: close to one in three children. Nearly one in four children in two-parent families lives in poverty which is nearly twice the provincial average and the highest rate out of all of the federal ridings in BC for couple-parent families. Child poverty rates for children in lone-parent families are more than double the rates of those in couple-parent families.
