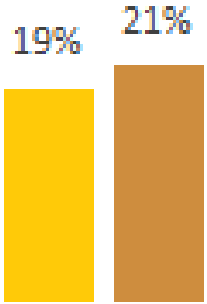
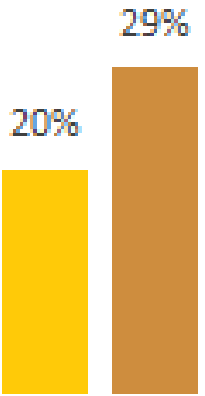

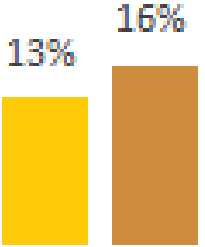
Poverty Rate for all Residents



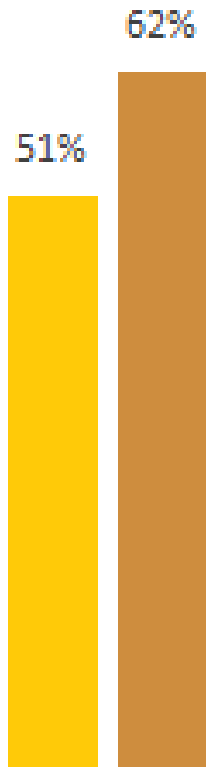
Poverty Rate for all Children

Federal Riding Highlights from the 2018 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Skeena-Bulkley Valley riding, 6,040 children are living in poverty, which is nearly one in three children. The overall child poverty rates here are the highest out of all of the federal ridings in British Columbia. Lone-parent families are at a particular risk for poverty with just over 3 out of 5 children of lone-parent families living in poverty. Child poverty rates are four times higher for children in lone-parent families than those in couple-parent families.
