

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Abbotsford riding, 3,900 children live in poverty, over one in six children. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with just over half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. Poverty rates for children in this area are over five times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

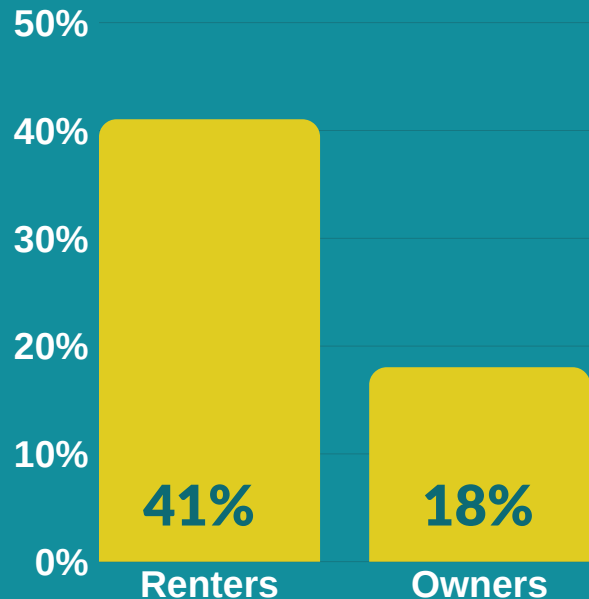

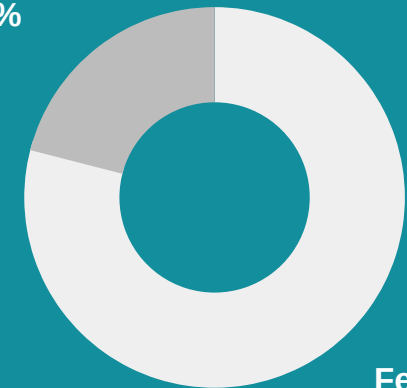
