

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Burnaby North-Seymour riding, 2,580 children live in poverty, over one in seven children. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with just under half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. Poverty rates for children in this area are over five times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

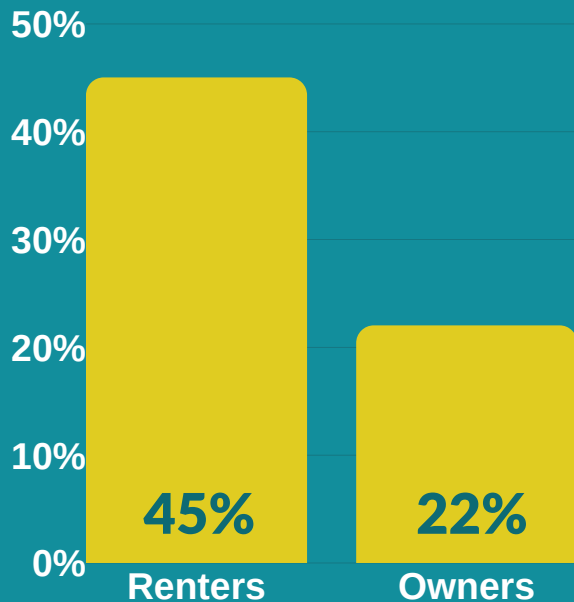

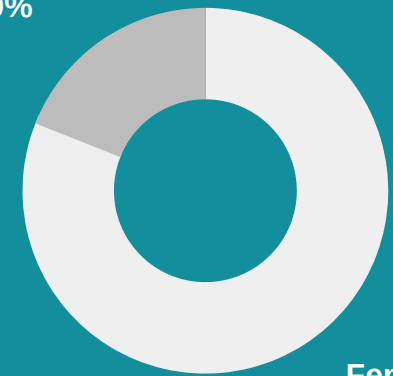
