

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Cariboo-Prince George riding, 5,290 children live in poverty, nearly one in four children. The poverty rate for children in this area is 5% higher than the poverty rate for all residents in the area, meaning children are disproportionately affected by poverty. Poverty rates for children in lone-parent families are over five times higher than those in couple-parent families.

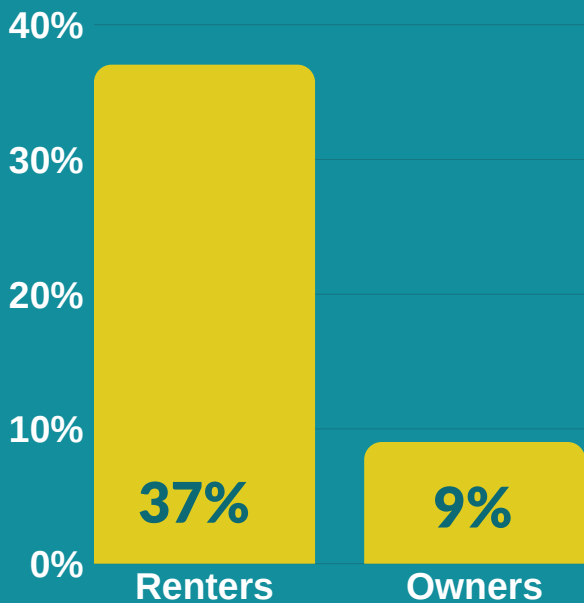

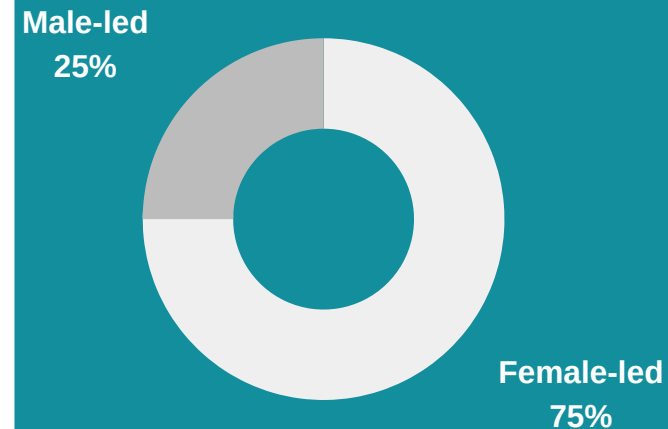
