

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Central Okanagan-Similkameen-Nicola riding, 3,900 children live in poverty, over one in five children. The poverty rate for children in this area is 6% higher than the poverty rate for all residents in the area, demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty here. Poverty rates for children in lone-parent families are over five times higher than those in couple-parent families.

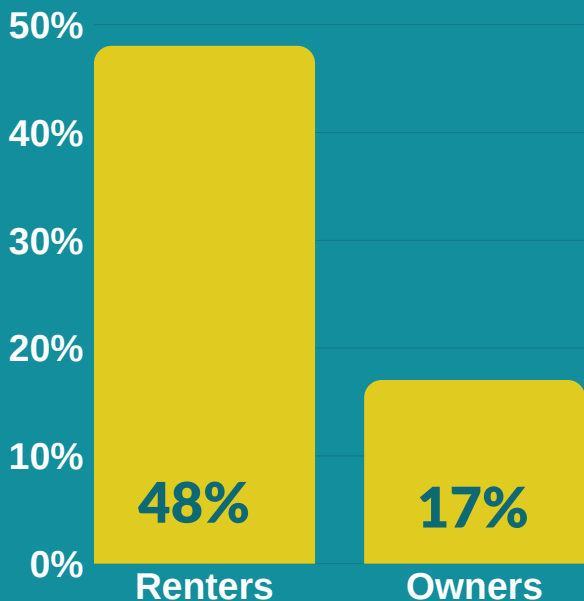
