

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Courtenay-Alberni riding, 4,440 children live in poverty, nearly one in four children. The child poverty rate is 7% higher than the overall poverty rate demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty here. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with rates over five times higher than children in couple-parent families.

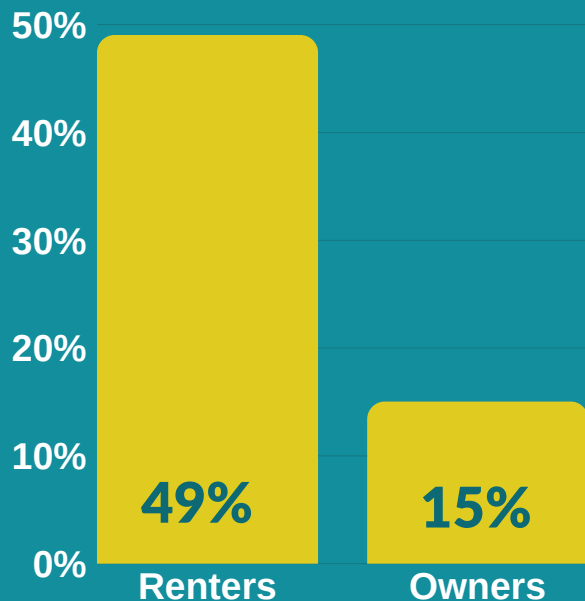

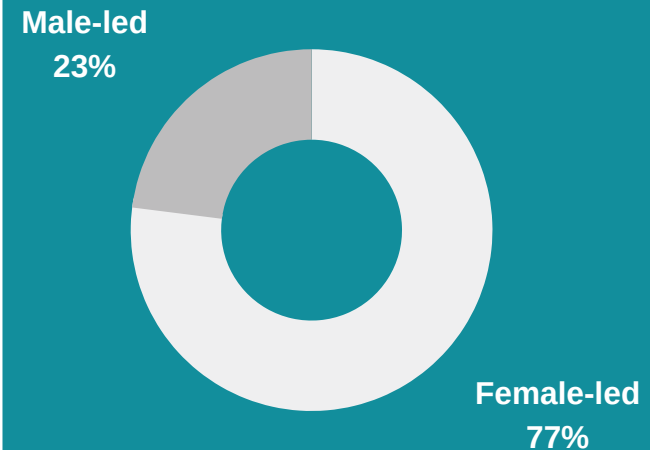
