

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Cowichan-Malahat-Langford riding, 4,570 children live in poverty, over one in five children. The child poverty rate is 5% higher than the overall poverty rate showing that children are disproportionately affected by poverty here. Children in lone-parent families are at particular with over half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty.

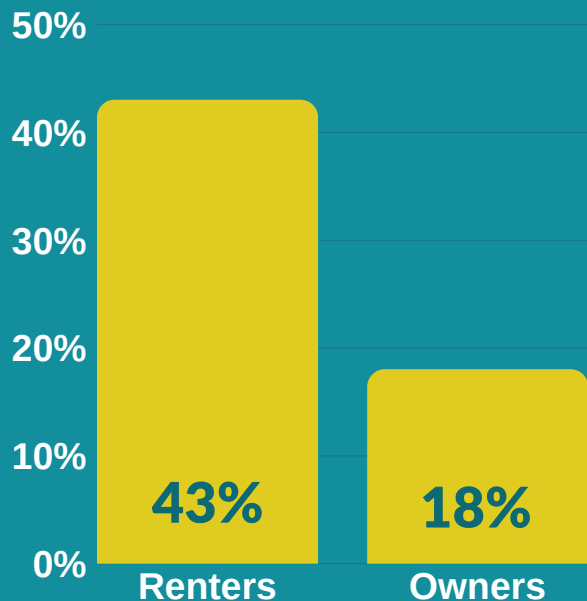

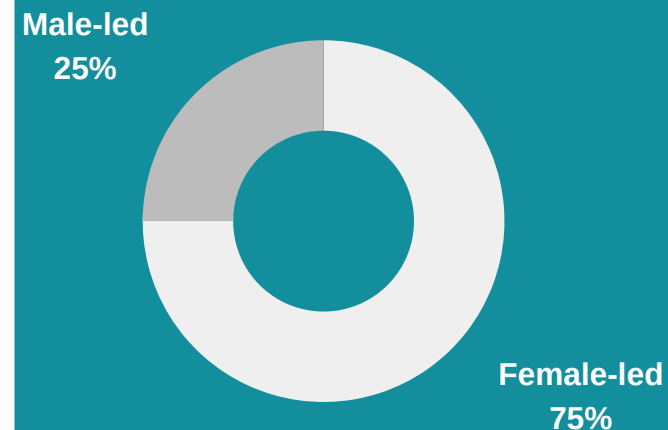
