

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Esquimalt-Saanich-Sooke riding, 3,220 children live in poverty, over one in seven children. This riding has one of the lowest couple-parent child poverty rates in BC at 7%, 15% lower than the highest rate in BC. Children in lone-parent families are at a much higher risk with rates over six times higher than those in couple-parent families.

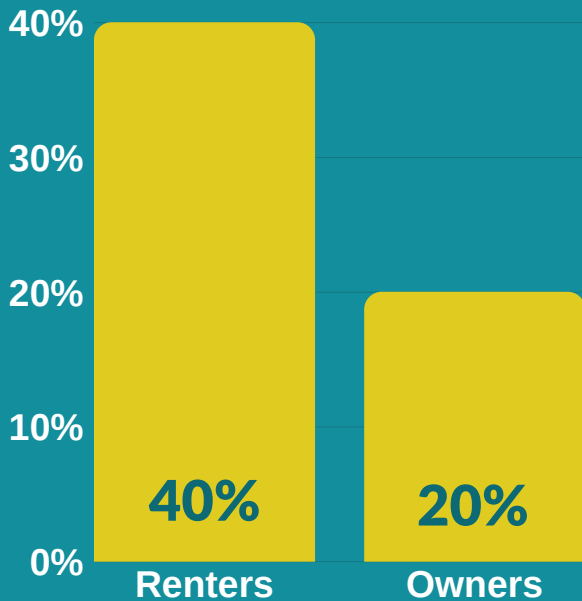

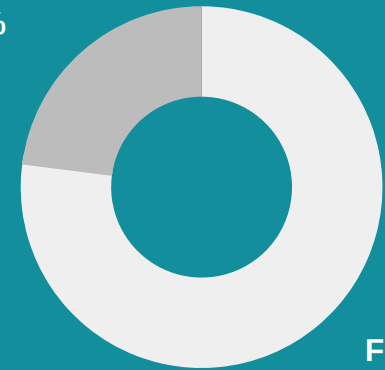
