

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Kamloops-Thompson-Cariboo riding, 4,380 children live in poverty, nearly one in five children. This riding has one of the lowest couple-parent child poverty rates in BC at 7%, 15% lower than the highest rate in BC. Unfortunately, the child poverty rate is still higher than the overall poverty rate in this area by 3%, demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty.

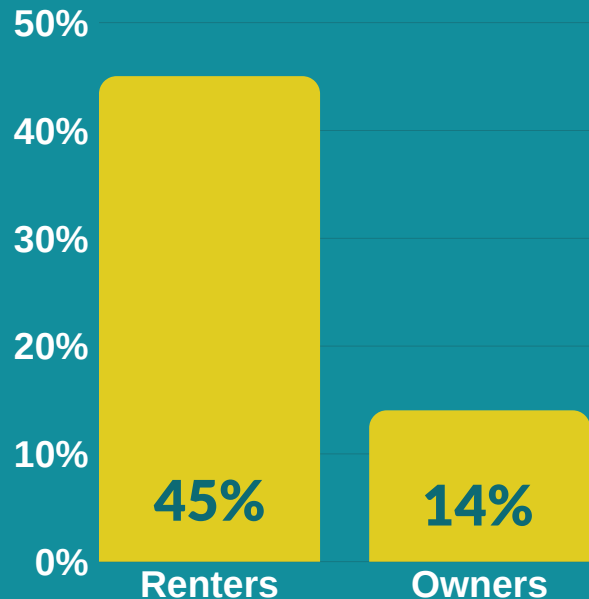

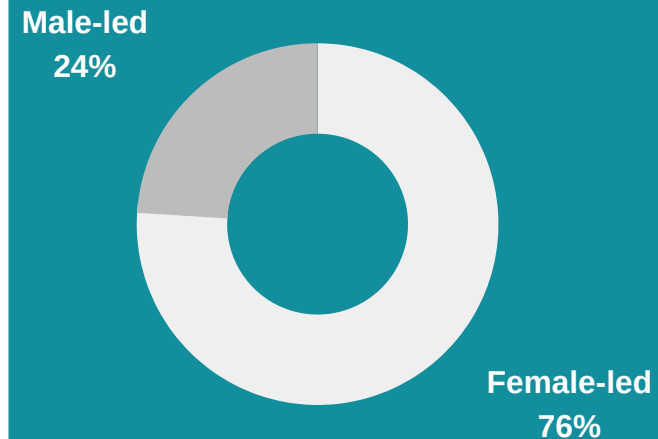
