

# BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Langley-Aldergrove riding, 3,530 children live in poverty, over one in eight children. The area has one of the lowest lone-parent poverty rates in BC at 44%. Unfortunately, this is still much higher than the overall child poverty rate of 13% and over six times higher than the couple-parent child poverty.

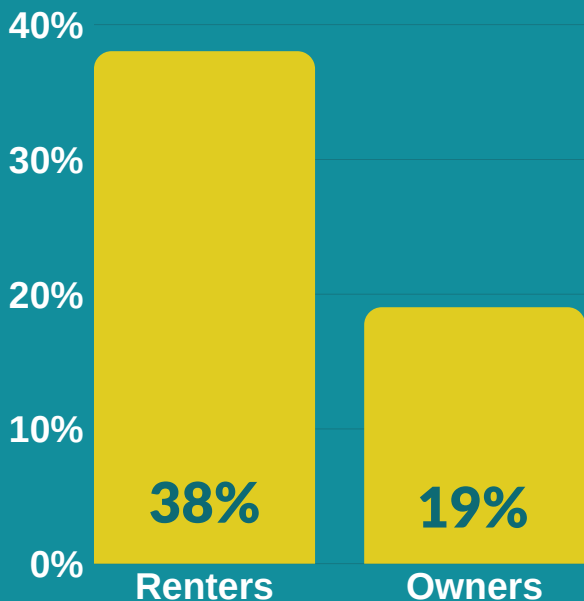
