

# BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Mission-Matsqui-Fraser Canyon riding, 4,460 children live in poverty, over one in five children. This riding has one of the highest lone-parent child poverty rates in BC at 57%. The lone-parent child poverty rate is five times higher than the couple-parent child poverty rate.

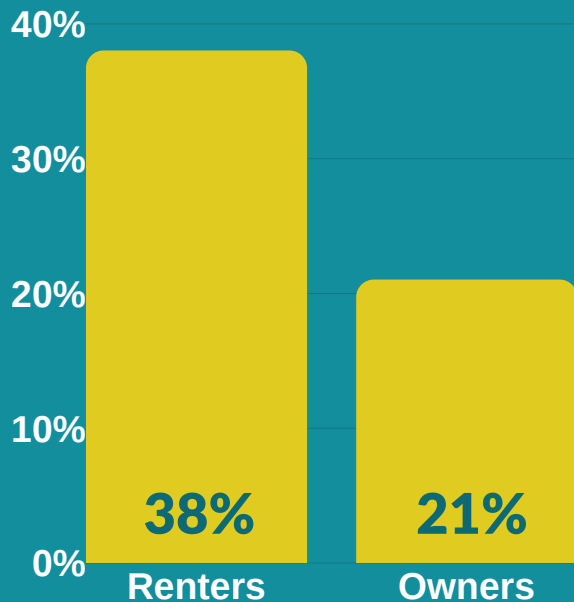

% of households spending >30% of income on shelter



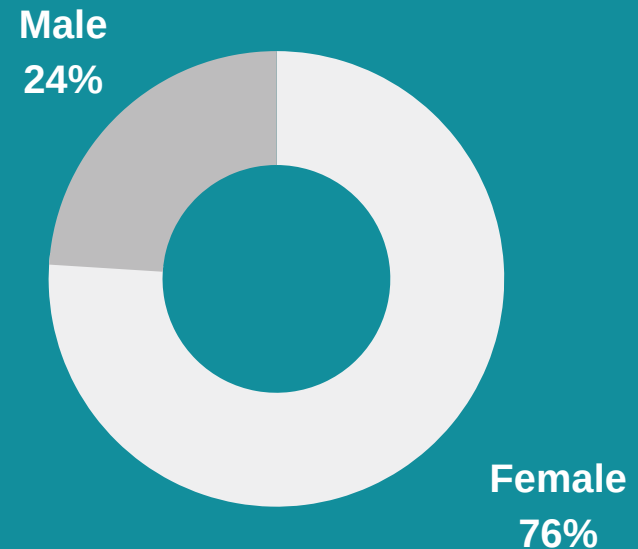
