

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the North Island-Powell River riding, 4,430 children live in poverty, nearly one in four children. This riding has one of the highest lone-parent child poverty rates in BC at 57%. Poverty rates for children in this area are nearly six times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

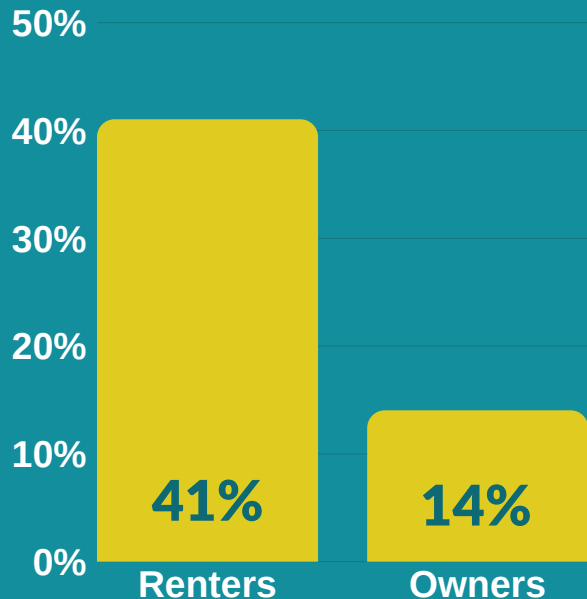

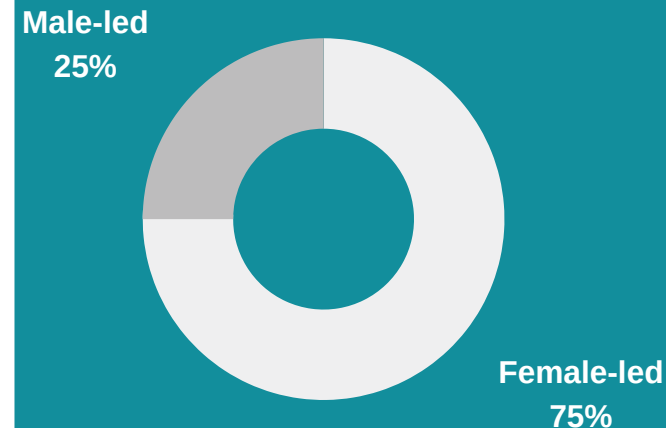
