

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the North Okanagan-Shuswap riding, 4,600 children live in poverty, one in five children. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with over half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. Poverty rates for children in this area are nearly six times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

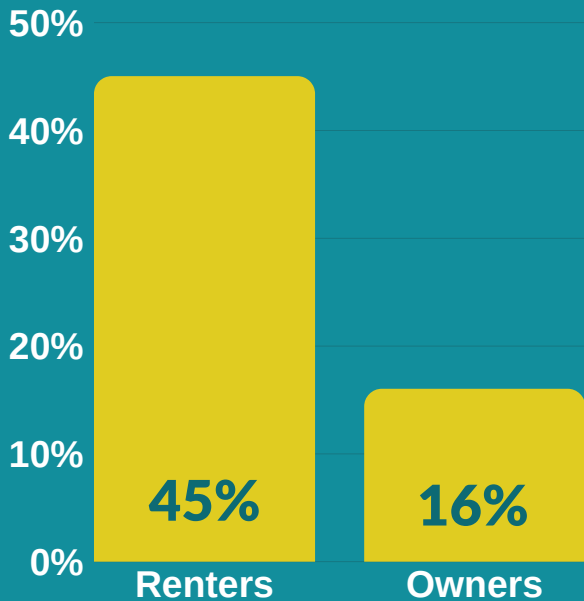

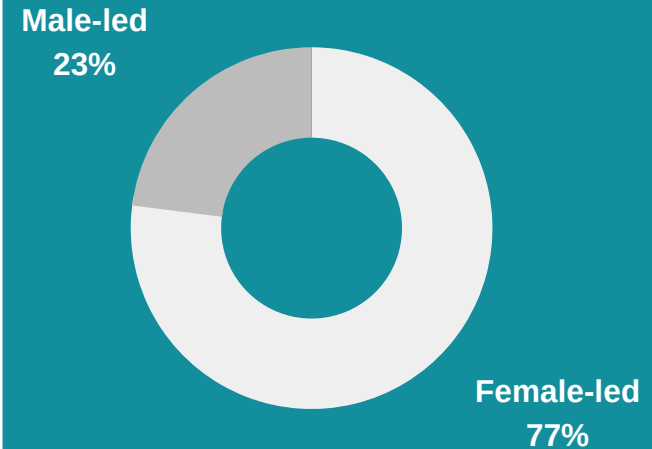
