

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Pitt Meadows-Maple Ridge riding, 2,790 children live in poverty, over one in seven children. This riding has the lowest couple-parent child poverty rate out of all the ridings in BC. Children in lone-parent families are at a higher risk with child poverty rates over seven times higher than children in couple-parent families in this riding.

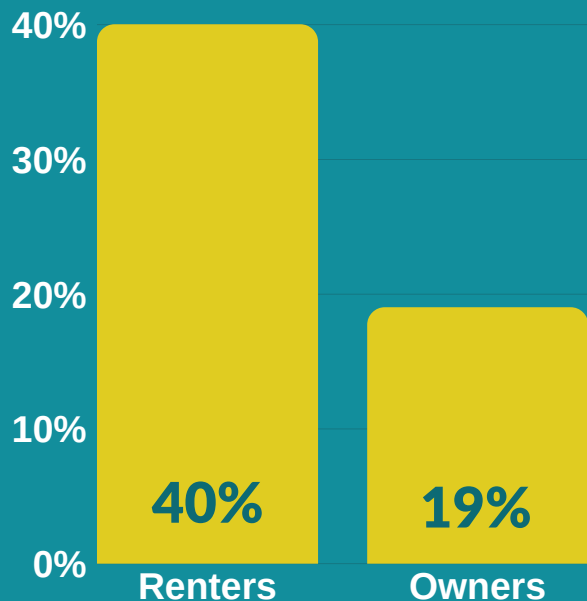

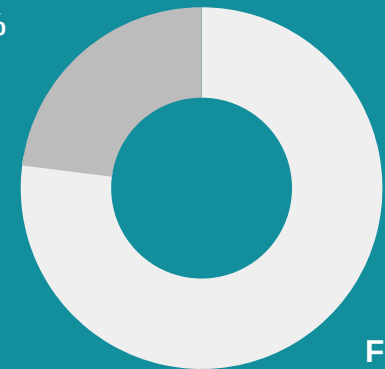
