

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Port Moody-Coquitlam riding, 3,530 children live in poverty, nearly one in five children. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with nearly half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. Poverty rates for children in this area are over four times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

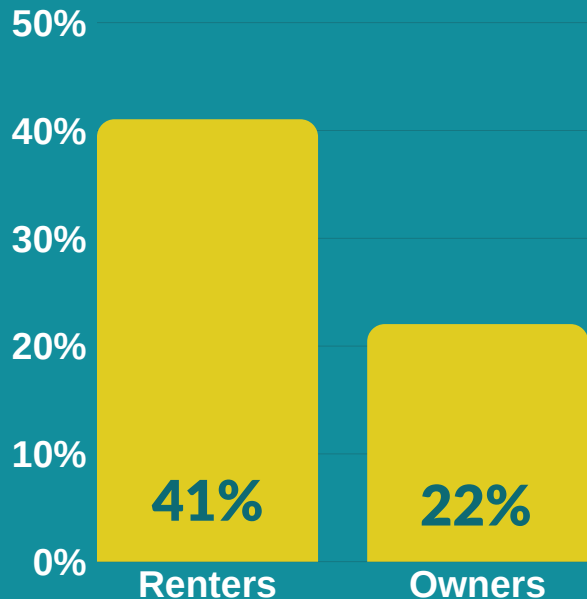

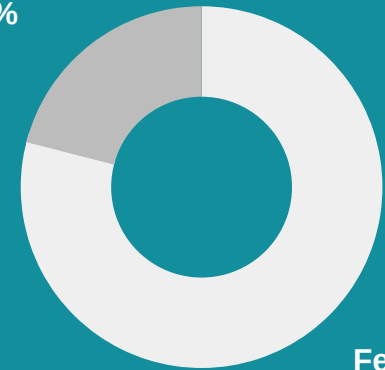
