

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Richmond Centre riding, 4,530 children live in poverty, one in every three and a half children. This riding has the highest couple-parent child poverty rate out of all the ridings in BC at 22%. Even so, children in lone-parent families are at a higher risk with over half of all children in lone-parent families living in poverty in this area.

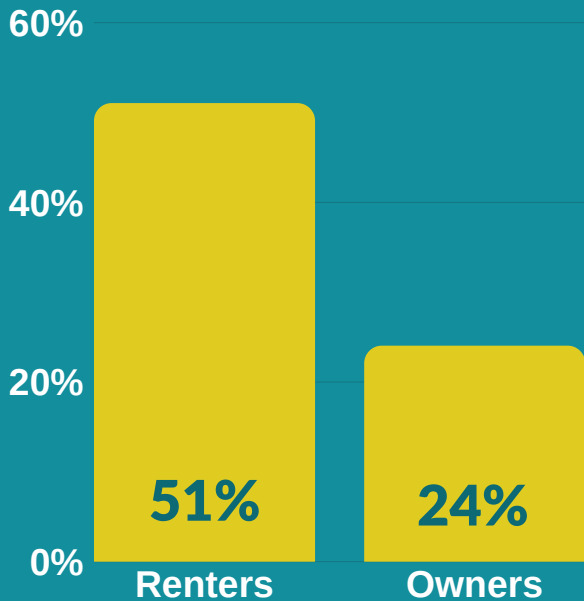

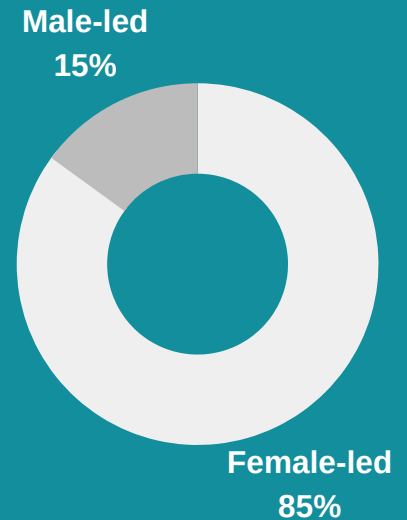
