

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Skeena-Bulkley Valley riding, 5,980 children live in poverty, nearly one in three children. The child poverty rate is significantly higher here than the overall poverty rate, the largest gap of all the BC ridings at 8% higher. The overall child poverty rate in this riding is the highest of all the ridings in BC at 29% of children. This riding has one of the highest lone-parent child poverty rates of all the BC ridings at 62%.

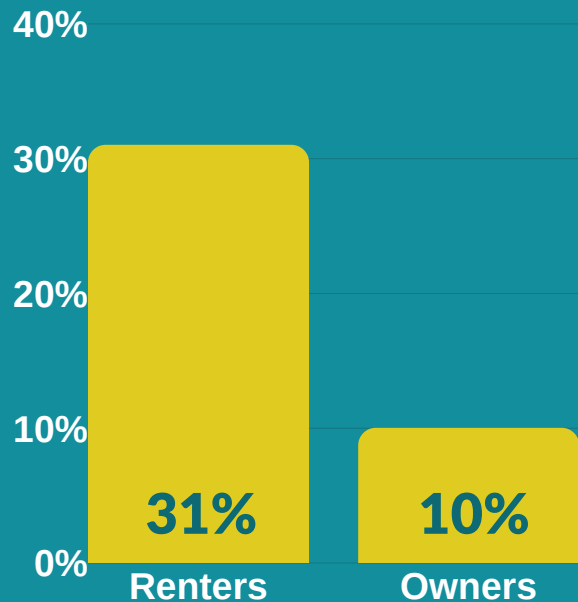
