

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the South Surrey-White Rock riding, 3,520 children live in poverty, one in five children. The child poverty rate is 3% higher than the overall poverty rate, indicating that children are at a higher risk of poverty in this area. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with nearly half of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. Poverty rates for children in this area are three and a half times higher for those in lone-parent families than those who live in couple-families.

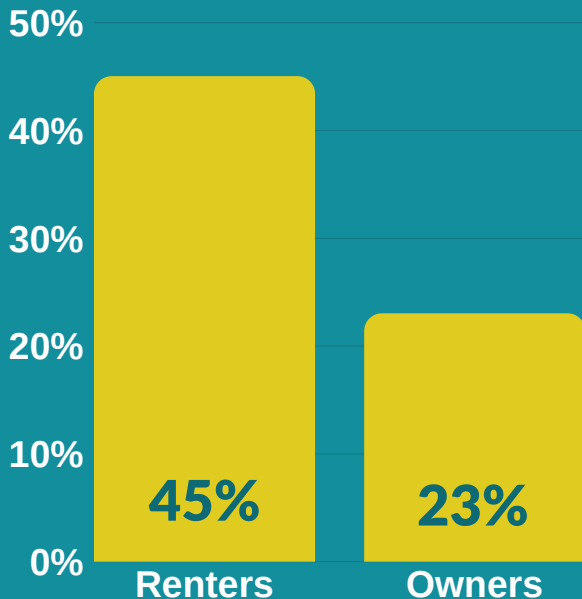

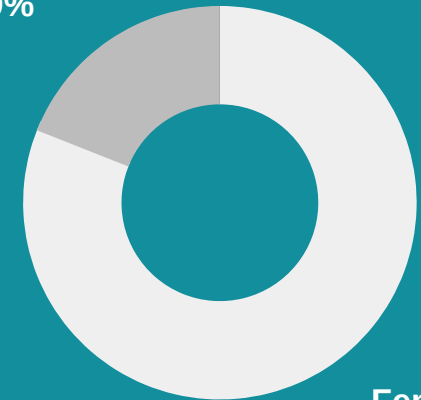
