

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Surrey Centre riding, 7,020 children live in poverty, the highest number of children in poverty of all the BC ridings. Surrey Centre has the highest lone-parent child poverty rate of all the ridings in BC. The lone-parent child poverty rate is three and a half times higher than the couple-parent child poverty rate in this area.

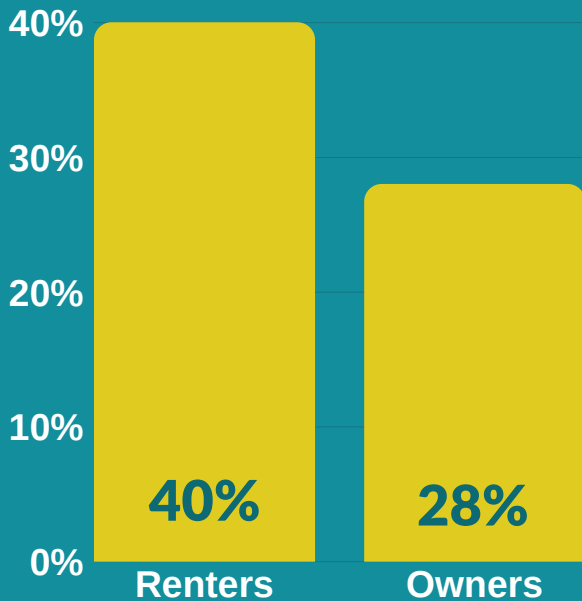

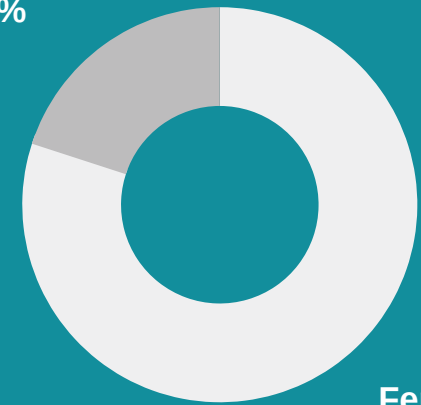
