

# BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Surrey-Newton riding, 5,540 children live in poverty, one in five children. This riding has one of the highest lone-parent child poverty rates of all the ridings at 57% of children, four times higher than the couple-parent child poverty rate in this riding.

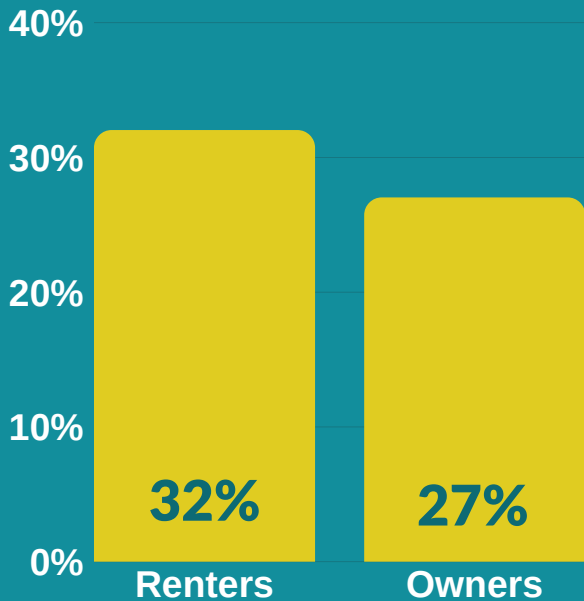

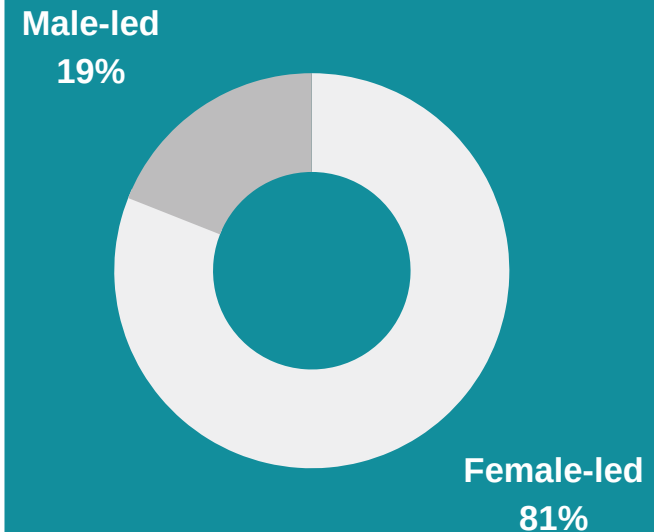
