

BC Federal Riding Poverty Statistics

In the Victoria riding, 2,640 children live in poverty, nearly one in five children. Victoria has one of the lowest lone-parent child poverty rates of all the BC ridings at 45%. Unfortunately, although one of the lowest rates, it still means nearly half of all children in lone-parent families live in poverty. The rate is five times higher than for children in couple-parent families.

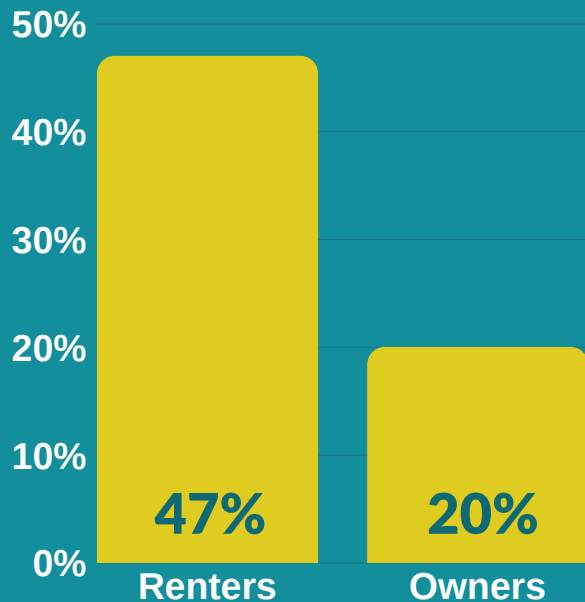

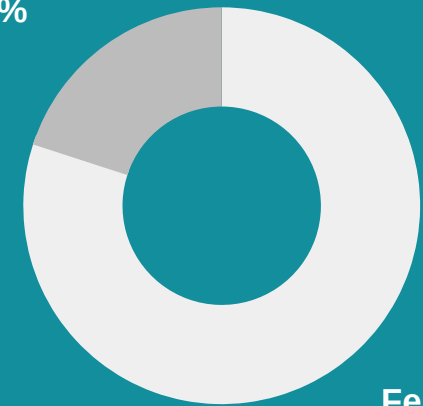
