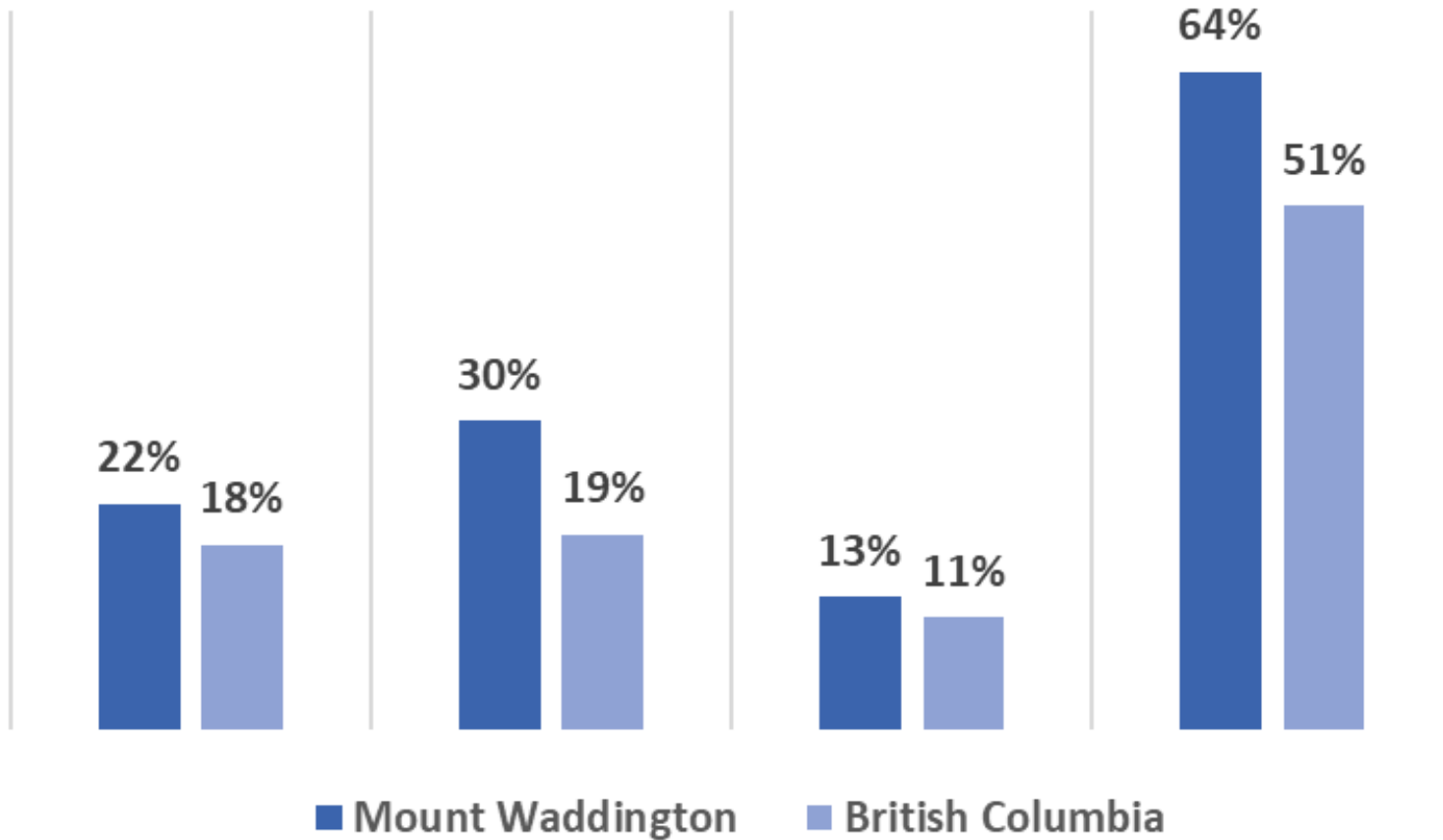

Regional highlights from the 2019 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Mount Waddington region, 630 children live in poverty, nearly one in three children. This area has the second highest lone-parent child poverty rate in BC, five times higher than the couple-parent child poverty rate in this region. The child poverty rate is 8% higher than the all resident poverty rate here, demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty.
