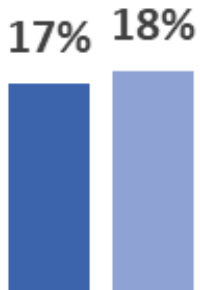

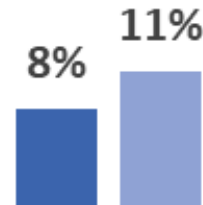
Poverty Rate for All Residents

# Regional highlights from the 2019 BC Child Poverty Report Card

In the Thompson-Nicola region, 5,110 children live in poverty, one in five children. Children in lone-parent families are at particular risk with lone-parent child poverty rates nearly seven times higher than they are for children in couple-parent families. The child poverty rate is 3% higher than the all resident poverty rate in this area, demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty in this area.
