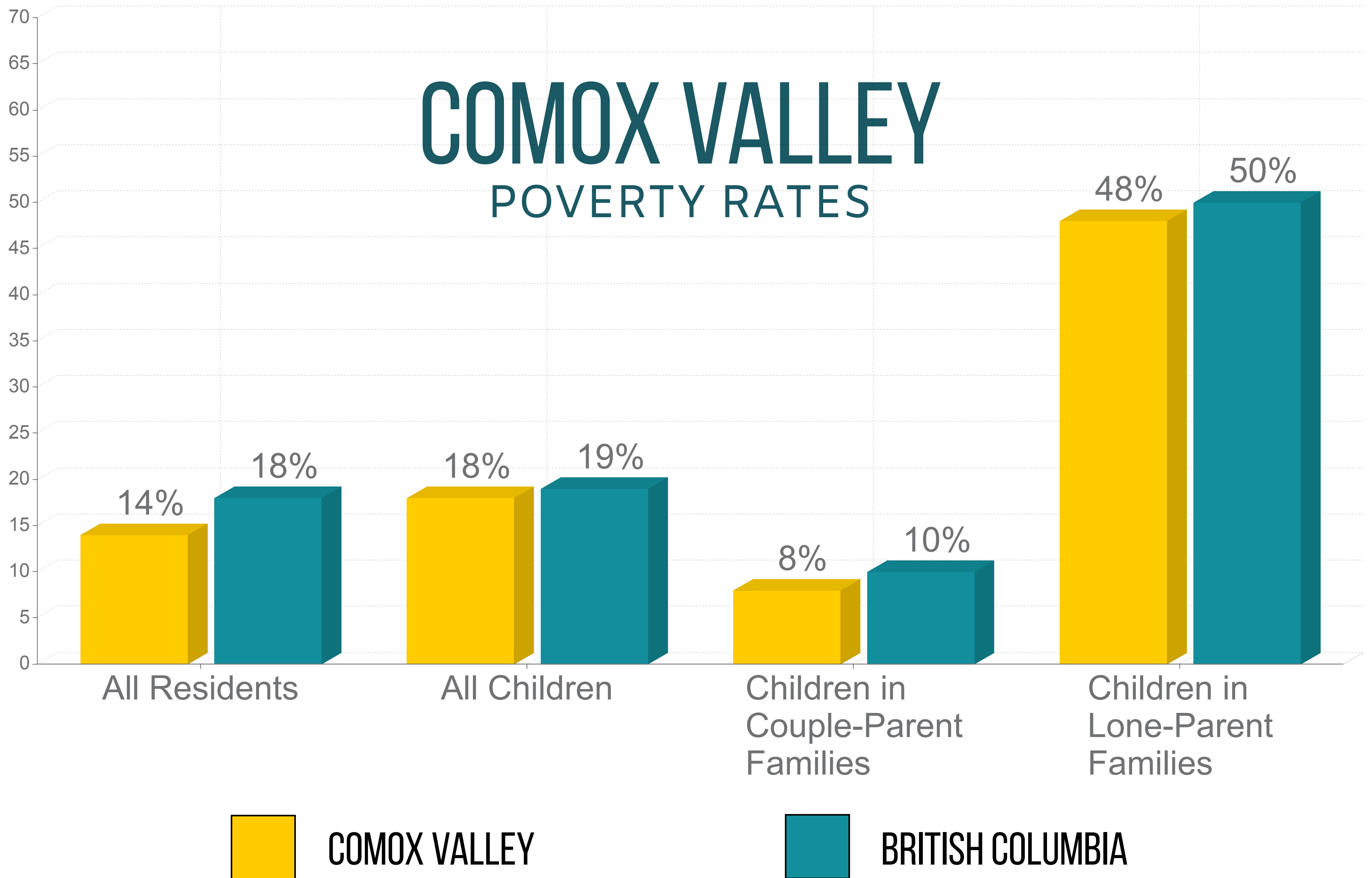

REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE 2020 BC POVERTY REPORT CARD

COMOX VALLEY

In the Comox Valley region, 2,050 (1 in 5) children live in poverty. The child poverty rate is 4 percentage points higher than the all-residents poverty rate in this area, demonstrating that children are disproportionately affected by poverty in this area. Children in lone-parent families are at the highest risk, with poverty rates over six times higher than the rates for children in couple-parent families.
