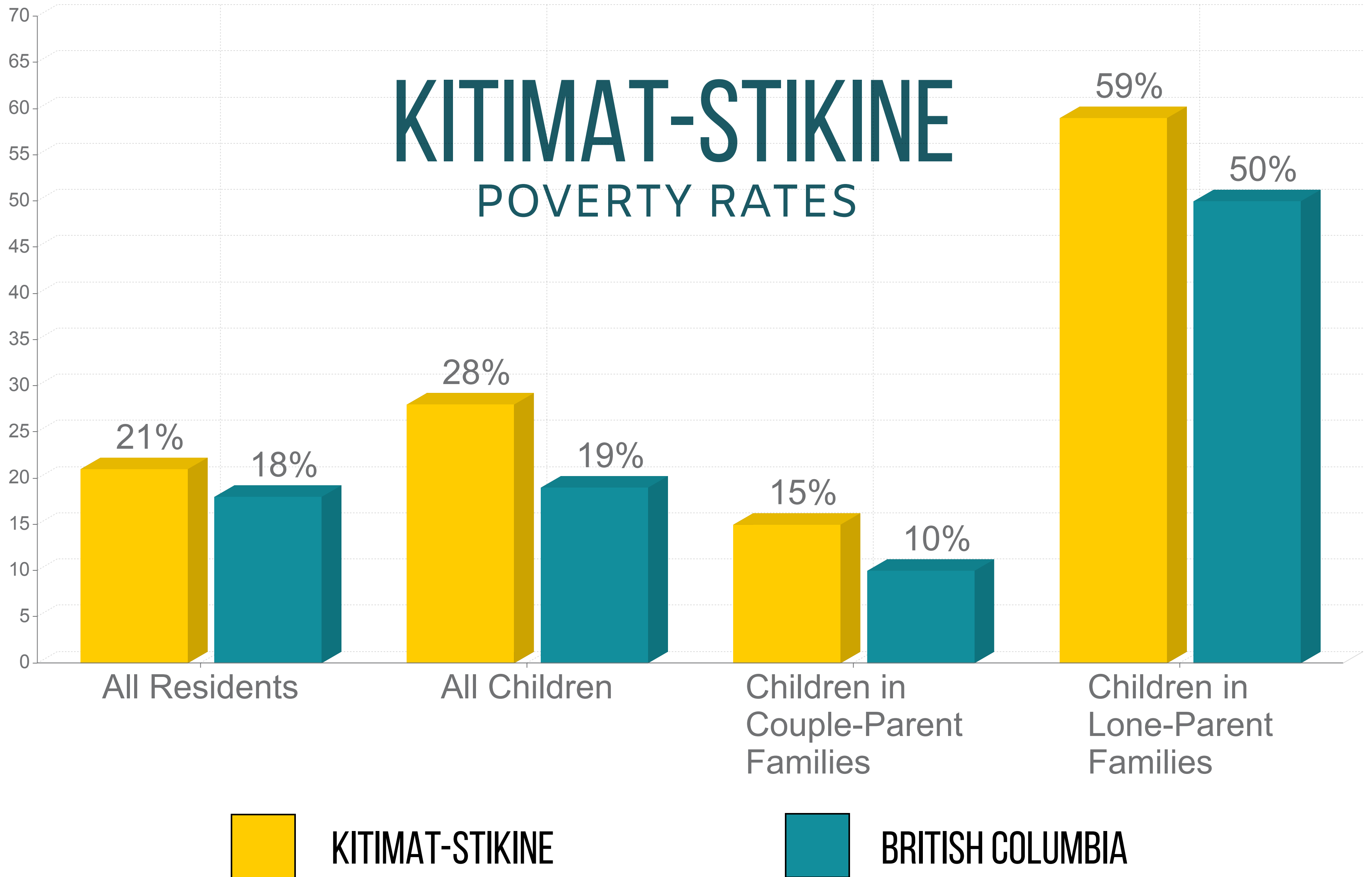

# REGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE 2020 BC POVERTY REPORT CARD

## KITIMAT-STIKINE

The Kitimat-Stikine region has one of the highest child poverty rates in BC with 2,320 (or nearly 1 in 3) children living in poverty. This area has high rates of child poverty across all family types, with almost 60% of children in lone-parent families living in poverty. The child poverty rate is 7 percentage points higher than the all-residents poverty rate in this region, demonstrating that children are disproportionately impacted by poverty.
